About the role

The hospital is a busy practice based alongside the Animal Shelter, which accepts surrendered, abandoned and neglected animals. You will be working within a small but dedicated team of Vets and Vet Nurses. The Clinic operates 7 days, therefore there is a requirement to work one weekend per month on a rotating basis. 60% of the job will be providing services to private clients, the other 40% will be supporting the shelter.

Our hospital is equipped with digital x-ray, in-house blood analytics, ultrasound, IM3 dental equipment and dental x-ray.
