

HELP DESEX A CAT



Our teams provide services to far flung communities as well as those in our backyard. We have provided health checks for animals in Tamworth, Nambucca, Orange and Taree this year in the aftermath of the drought and bushfires.

JESS' STORY



In November 2019, catastrophic bushfires tore through the town of Wingham NSW, quickly wiping out everything in its path. **CEO Mark Slater travelled to the area to** provide aid, helping Taree local Pat flee from her burning property. Pat lost everything, barely escaping with the clothes on her back. Pat's Kelpie Jess survived the horrific scenes after she sought refuge in a nearby dam. Sadly, Jess was badly burned however with Mark's quick thinking, Jess received immediate medical care before being treated intensively by AWL NSW veterinarians soon after. Jess is a fighter and made a full recovery after her ordeal, thanks to the care received by our team.



PROVIDE VITAL PARASITE PROTECTION

BENNY'S STORY

2-year-old Benny was found wandering the streets of Western Sydney with a severe leg injury that was painful and debilitating. A Good Samaritan found this poor boy and brought him into the care and safety of Animal Welfare League NSW. Our veterinarians performed immediate x-rays which confirmed a fracture. Benny then went on to receive corrective surgery for his broken leg and is now in the protection of a loving foster carer where his leg is healing.

HELP FEED THE HUNGRY



CAT RESCUE

Earlier this year, Animal Welfare League NSW inspectors went to the aid of a poor and very sick cat who was stuck down a drain. Our Inspectors spent hours attempting to retrieve the cat that had sadly become trapped. After some time, Inspector Mahon was finally able to secure the cat and bring her to safety. The cat was taken to our vet clinic to receive immediate veterinary care.

YOUR GIFT WILL HELP CONTINUE TO ASSIST ANIMALS IN NEED

Helping our native wildlife and those affected by the bushfire crisis

In January this year, Animal Welfare League NSW were first responders to help animals and their families during the bushfire emergency on the NSW Far South Coast. Our staff and volunteers spent two weeks providing critical first aid and care to animals that had been burnt or injured as well as providing vital supplies to families and those at the local evacuation centres.

"I was surprised to discover this echidna whilst out in the field. I did not hold high hopes considering the devastation around us, but thankfully this little guy was given a clean bill of health by our vet team and was safely returned to his native forest." - Daniel, Mobile Vet Team





BRANDY'S STORY



In February this year, following a catastrophic bushfire season, parts of NSW experienced rapid flooding which was soon declared yet another natural disaster. Our team was made aware of a young goat that had become trapped in rising floodwaters and rushed to her aid. With some quick thinking and skill, our team were able to get the goat to safety. Nicknamed Brandy by her rescuers, the goat was given a thorough check by our veterinarians and despite the stressful ordeal, Brandy escaped with only a few scratches and went on to live at a sanctuary.

REX'S STORY

Animal Welfare League NSW inspectors attended an address in Sydney, after receiving serious allegations of cruelty to a dog named Rex. Inspectors gained access to the backyard of the property and sighted a large brindle crossbreed. The dog's skin was flakey, cracked, bloodied and appeared to be painful and itchy. He was covered in live fleas over his entire body and constantly scratching and biting at his skin and appeared distressed.

Our inspectors noticed that the dogs right hind leg appeared to be deformed, sticking out and possibly dislocated. He had difficulty standing up, walking, going to the toilet and weight-bearing on the injured leg. The owner was questioned in relation to this injury however didn't know how the injury was sustained. It was further stated his leg had been like that for 2 days.

The dog was seized from the property and returned to Animal Welfare League NSW for a full veterinary assessment and treatment. The owner was charged with cruelty offences under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act.

The Defendant was found guilty and fined \$1500:

 Failed to Provide Veterinary Treatment -Coxofemoral Luxation (Hip dislocation)


GUILTY - FINED \$1000


2. Failed to Provide Veterinary Treatment – External parasites (Fleas)

GUILTY - FINED \$500

The Defendant was placed on a prohibition order - Prohibited from owning any animals for a period of 5 years.









BROCK'S STORY

On the 30th of October 2017, a 10-year-old male Foxhound was surrendered to the Animal Welfare League NSW Inspectorate after it was found his previous owner was not able to care for him due to illness. Brock spent almost a year with our vets and shelter teams - putting on weight and learning how to be a very good boy. After passing his medical and behavioural assessments, Brock was made available to adopt from our Kemps Creek shelter on 8th October 2018. After spending 820 days with us, and after a short stay in foster care, beautiful Brock was adopted in January 2020 after his foster-dads fell in love with him and decided to make him part of the family.


