As per the requirement of Animal Welfare League New South Wales (AWL NSW) as an approved charitable organisation under Section 34B(3) of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1979, I am writing to report to the Minister, The Honorable Tara Moriarty, of the exercise of powers by AWL NSW Inspectors under the Act for the twelve month period ending 30 June 2023.

As at 30 June 2023 the AWL NSW Inspectorate employs five Authorised Officers. Inspectors

1. Four Inspectors are Greater Sydney Metropolitan Area based and one Regional Inspector is based in the Central Tablelands.

As per Section 34 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Regulation 2012, listed below is information obtained from statistics held by AWL NSW Inspectorate for the period 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023:
